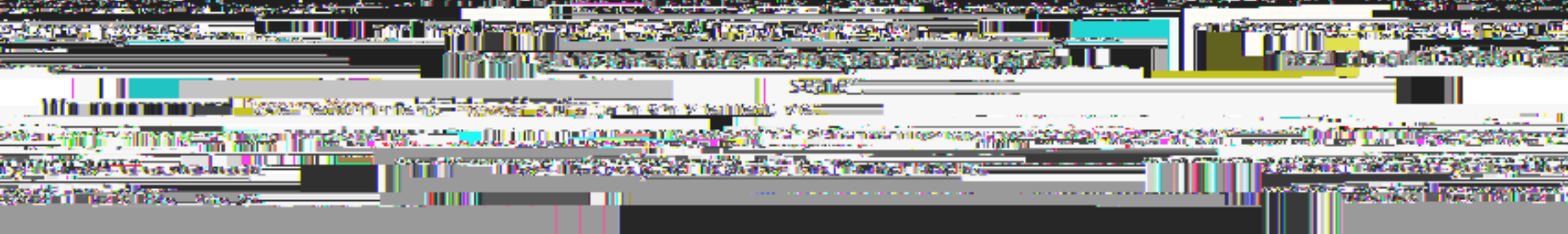

In these cases, a 7-step system consists



of the following steps: 1. Pre-cleaning with a degreaser to remove oils and greases. 2. Application of an alkaline cleaner to break down the grout dirt. 3. Scrubbing the grout with a stiff brush. 4. Rinsing the area with water. 5. Application of an acidic cleaner to neutralize the alkaline cleaner and remove any remaining dirt. 6. Rinsing the area with water. 7. Sealing the grout with a grout sealer to protect it from future staining.



Sealant. Rub it in at full strength. Restoration: Dilute Power Extra at 1:3 with warm to
